

**CONTEST RULES
FOR FANS OF THE GAME 'THE
ALTERS'**

§1

Contest

1 The organizer of the Contest (hereinafter referred to as the "**Contest**") is 11 bit studios S.A. with its seat in Warsaw (hereinafter referred to as the "**Organizer**").

(2) As part of the Contest, during its duration, the Contest participants, referred to in § 2 Paragraph 1, (hereinafter: "**Regulations**"), shall submit audio-video materials (hereinafter: "**Material**") with technical parameters indicated on the Organizer's Website.

(3) The Contest will be held from July 12, 2024 to July 31, 2024 (hereinafter: "**Duration**") in an online form, and submissions may be submitted to the Organizer through a form posted on alterscontest.com (hereinafter: "**Website**").

(4) The prizes in the Contest are not in-kind or monetary, and the Organizer is the founder of the Contest.

(7) The Organizer declares that the Contest is not a game of chance, fantasy lottery, pari-mutuel betting, promotional lottery, the results of which depend on chance, or any other form of game of chance provided for in the Act of November 19, 2009 on gambling games (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2022, item 888).

(8) Participation in the Contest is free of charge.

§2

Conditions of participation in the Contest

(1) The Contest is open only to persons of legal age (18 years of age or older), who make the statements required by the Regulations regarding the Materials, as well as express the consents and statements provided for in the Regulations. (hereinafter: "**Participants**").

(2) A prerequisite for participating in the Contest is to submit, during the Contest Period, audio and video Materials, which, depending on the outcome of the Contest, may be posted within the Organizer's game titled "The Alters" (hereinafter referred to as the "**Game**").

(3) The condition to participate in the Contest is:

a. at the latest at the time of sending the Material to the Organizer, granting permission by the Participant, to include the Material in the Game, to process it (including editing) for the purpose necessary for its inclusion in the Game, to publish it and to exploit it together with the Game in any way in which the Game will be exploited and not to remove it from the Game for the entire period of exploitation of the Game,

b. at the latest at the time of sending the Material to the Organizer, granting permission by the Participant to use the Material to the extent as above also for the Organizer's marketing purposes in promoting the Contest, the Game and the Organizer's activities e.g. on social media,

c. consent to the processing of the Participant's personal data (including image, voice, etc.) to the extent consistent with the purpose of the Contest,

d. a statement that the Material is the result of the Participant's personal and original activity, complies with good morals, does not violate the law or infringe the rights or property of any third party (including copyrights, image rights or personal property), does not contain defamatory content, inciting discrimination on any grounds,

(4) Each Participant in the Contest may participate once, and entries are made individually.

(5) Participation in the Contest is associated with the voluntary submission of personal data of the Participant enabling his participation in the Contest, identification and possible awarding of the Prize, as well as his image. At the same time, the condition of participation in the Contest is the voluntary provision of personal data referred to in the preceding sentence, and the information clause containing, among other things, information about the personal data Administrator, the method and purpose of processing the Entrant's personal data and his/her rights are available on the Website, and constitute Appendix No. 1 to the Regulations.

(6) The Participant acknowledges that failure to provide data as indicated in paragraph 5 as well as submitting false statements will make it impossible for the Participant to participate in the Contest or for the Prize to be awarded, if applicable.

(8) In case of non-compliance with the Contest Regulations or the Entrant's behavior contrary to the law, good manners or rules of social coexistence, the Organizer may exclude the Entrant from the Contest.

§3

Contest results and prizes

(1) The course of the Contest is supervised by a jury appointed for this purpose by the Organizer (hereinafter: "Jury"). The composition of the Jury shall be determined by the Organizer.

(2) At the end of the Duration, depending on the final number of time windows provided for in the Game, which is not dependent on the Jury, but on the development team, the Jury will proceed to determine the winner or winners of the Contest.

(3) The Jury will take into account the originality of the Materials, aesthetics and the number of time windows provided for in the Game.

(4) The prize in the Contest is the inclusion of the winning Material or Materials (depending on the number of time slots in the Game - hereinafter: the "Prize") in the Game, and its distribution with the Game in accordance with the manner of its exploitation for the duration of its exploitation.

(5) The Jury's decision on the selection of the winner or winners of the Contest and the awarding of Prizes to them shall be final. The Jury may also refrain from selecting a winner, e.g. in the event of a lack of time windows in the Game.

(6) The decision on the award of the Prize and its presentation will be made after Duration. Winners Participants will be notified of the Jury's decision to the email indicated at the time of application.

(7) At any time, for the duration of the operation of the Game, the Organizer may remove the Material from the Game, despite the awarding of the Prize, in the event that it is found that the Material posted in the Game violates or has violated the terms of the Regulations, the statements made in the Application were untrue or have become outdated, or the Material otherwise violates the rights

of third parties, has become unlawful or damages the reputation of the Organizer.

§4

Final Provisions

(1) The Organizer reserves the right to change the Terms and Conditions, including the right to change the date of the Contest, or its termination in the event of exhaustion of the Prize pool.

(2) The Organizer reserves the right to:

1) withdraw from organizing the Contest without giving any reason;

2) not resolve the Contest;

(3) Disputes related to the interpretation of the Regulations or issues not covered by the Regulations shall be resolved by the Organizer.

(4) Reading the Regulations and accepting them is a condition for entering the Contest.

(5) In matters not regulated by these Regulations, Polish law and the provisions of the Civil Code shall apply.
